Adoption Tax Credit

When you are preparing your tax return don't forget your adoption expenses that incurred in your "adoption period".

The "adoption period" starts when you open an adoption file with the Provincial Ministry who is responsible for adoption or a licensed adoption agency licensed by the government. The "adoption period" ends when the time an adoption order is issued or recognized by the government in Canada and is completed, or when the child begins to reside permanently with the family if this occurs later.

The amount eligible for adoption expenses is a maximum \$10,643 that you or your spouse/ common-law partner paid in that period.
